

## Short Biography of Terutaka KUWAHARA

Terutaka KUWAHARA serves as Deputy Director General of National Institute of Science and Technology Policy (NISTEP), Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) since April 2005. He also serves as Visiting Professor at National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS). He started working for NISTEP in 1989 after administrative works such as life science, nuclear energy and S&T information in the ministry. As a member of NISTEP, he has conducted the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth Japanese Delphi survey as well as international Delphi study with Germany. He has organized international foresight conferences and took part in the activities of APEC Technology Foresight Center. He also served as Planning Director for Research and Analysis, Council for Science and Technology Policy, Cabinet Office (CSTP).
